

**TOWN OF ROSETOWN
BYLAW NO. 763-17**

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ROSETOWN TO FIX THE RATES FOR THE USE OF THE SEWER TO BE CHARGED BY WAY OR RENT OR SERVICE CHARGE AGAINST PERSONS WHO OWN OR OCCUPY PREMISES DRAINED OR WHICH BY BYLAW ARE REQUIRED TO BE DRAINED INTO A SEWER

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary that the properties or premises drained, or required by bylaw to be drained, into a sewer of the said Town shall be charged a reasonable rent or service charge for use of the said sewer;

AND WHEREAS the Council may by bylaw regulate the times when and the manner in which the rent is to be paid;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Rosetown enacts as follows:

1. Persons who own or occupy premises drained or required by bylaw to be drained into the sewer shall pay for such service, a monthly rent or service charge which shall be based on the value of the water consumed in a month as set out by the Town of Rosetown Bylaw passed for this purpose.
2. That the said charges shall be as follows:
 - a. For the period of January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017 a Ten Percent (10%) of the said value of water used and shall be subject to a six dollar (\$6.00) basic monthly charge for each sewer connection which shall apply to all types of users of the sewer service.
 - b. For the period of January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018 a Fifteen Percent (15%) of the said value of water used and shall be subject to a eight dollar (\$8.00) basic monthly charge for each sewer connection which shall apply to all types of users of the sewer service.
 - c. For the period of January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019 a Fifteen Percent (15%) of the said value of water used and shall be subject to a nine dollar (\$9.00) basic monthly charge for each sewer connection which shall apply to all types of users of the sewer service.
3. The rent or service charge hereby imposed shall be charged monthly and shall be paid at the Town Office when billed on the water service accounts of the Town. The charge shall be due and payable in the same manner as that set out for the collection of water accounts.
4. If any rate, charge or rent remains unpaid on December 31 of the year in which it becomes payable, the amount of the rate, charge or rent shall be added to and thereby forms part of the taxes on the land or buildings with respect to which the service was provided.
5. Bylaw No. 743-16 and any amending bylaws are hereby repealed.

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6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval of the Saskatchewan Municipal Board Local Government Committee.
