



## Inform your election candidates on their responsibilities as an elected official

To encourage participation in municipal governance and increase understanding of what it means to be on council, Municipalities of Saskatchewan has created Municipal Governance 101, virtual education sessions designed for anyone who has an interest in municipal politics or who is thinking of running for council.

The first virtual education session, **Municipal Governance 101: Introduction to Local Government**, will be held on **September 1 at 6:30 p.m.** In coordination with the Ministry of Government Relations, this session will cover:
