

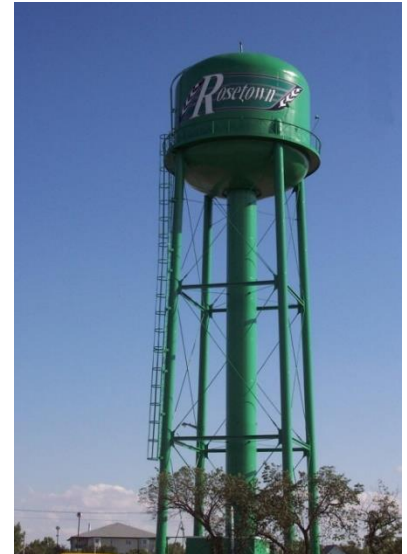

Schools are opened. Please remember that children are walking and biking to and from school.

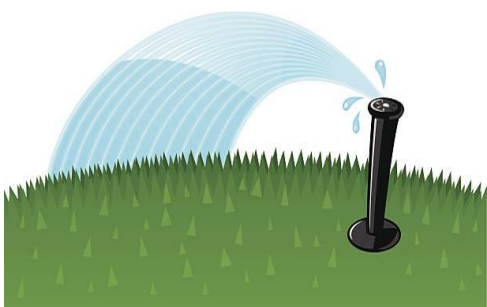
As we drive through school zones, please slow down to 30 km/h.



### Civic Addressing Bylaw #709-15

“Each house or building in the Town of Rosetown shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated.”

After a very dry summer, the Town of Rosetown has removed the watering restrictions as of September 1, 2021. As we water our yards, it is also a good time to deal with the relentless weeds that seemed to thrive in the heat.



A building or house number which is easily read from the street can save valuable time for emergency services responding to an emergency call, or if you notice a situation at a commercial or residential property and call 911, they will request a building number.

The property numbers shall be posted within 1 meter of the front street entrance or in a manner to be visible on the street which the property is located.

If you do not already have a number on your house, business or building, you are encouraged to do so. The Fire Department and RCMP will thank you.

## False Alarm's



A false alarm means an activation of an alarm system which results in a response by the R.C.M.P. or the Rosetown Fire Department, where unauthorized entry to the alarmed premises has not occurred and no police or fire department emergency exists.

“Where a false alarm is activated, the organization or individual having care and control of the alarm site, shall, upon demand, pay a response fee to the Town of Rosetown as set out in Schedule “B” of Bylaw #601-10.”

### **SCHEDULE “B” Fire Department Response Fees**

(a)	First false alarm	<b>Verbal Warning - No fee</b>
(b)	Second false alarm	<b>Written Warning – No fee</b>
(c)	Each subsequent false alarm within a period of 12 months commencing from the date of the first false alarm	<b>\$400.00</b>

Do you know that your home alarm system needs regular maintenance to ensure it functions optimally, this involves inspecting the individual components and checking the batteries.

If you have a false alarm, you need to

1. Stay Calm
2. Disarm your system
3. Call your monitoring company to report a false alarm
4. The monitor company will attempt to cancel the emergency dispatch

Make sure your family or other residents know your alarm pin number and the alarm company phone number.



When landscaping and planting trees, please ensure that all trees and shrubs are planted within your property line and not in the back alley or the boulevards.

Littering simply means **throwing away objects on the ground** or leaving them lying on the ground instead of disposing of them in a garbage can, recycling bin or trash container.

Lets all do our part to keep Rosetown clean and beautiful, don't litter.
