

**TOWN OF ROSETOWN
BYLAW NO. 872-22**

**A BYLAW TO THE TOWN OF ROSETOWN, IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN, TO PROVIDE FOR THE CREATION OF A SPECIAL TAX
WITHIN THE CURRENT YEAR.**

WHEREASE the Council of the Town of Rosetown deems it desirable and necessary to raise Three Hundred and Sixty-Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred Dollars (\$369,900.00) for the annual maintenance and repair of streets and sewer main lining of ten (10) Blocks on 6th Avenue East and Main Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Rosetown, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. That pursuant to Section 312(1) of The Municipalities Act, a special tax based on each assessed residential, commercial and industrial property is to be levied as follows:
 - a. A flat rate of \$300.00 per taxable assessed residential, commercial and industrial property.
2. Revenue raised by this Special Tax shall be utilities within the 2021 Budget for the annual maintenance and repair of streets and sewer main lining of ten (10) Blocks On 6th Avenue East and Main Street.
3. That interested persons may request that the Town of Rosetown review the application or calculation of this Special Tax on property if they believe that an error or omission was made in that application or calculation.
4. That Bylaw No. 852-21 is hereby repealed.
5. This bylaw shall come into force and effect upon final passing by the Council of the Town of Rosetown.
