

**The Town of Rosetown**  
**Bylaw No. 895-24**  
**A Bylaw to Amend Bylaw No. 812-19 (The Animal Control Bylaw)**

The Council of the Town of Rosetown, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That section 18 of Bylaw No. 812-19 (The Animal Control Bylaw) be amended to read as follows:

**18. Conservation Officer or Designated Pest Control Officer Privileges**

The Town awards authorization to discharge a firearm within Town Limits to:

- a) provincial Conservation Officers; and
- b) designated Pest Control Officers who have been appointed by resolution of Council and as defined in Bylaw 746-16 (The Firearms and Fireworks Bylaw), in conjunction with a permit from the Conservation Officers; when:
  - 1) an Animal is threatening the life of an individual or another Animal;
  - 2) wildlife has entered the Town limits and is deemed to be a nuisance and cannot be safely removed through other means, or;
  - 3) a sick or injured Animal that is found within the Town and immediate euthanizing of the Animal is required in order to avoid unnecessary suffering of the Animal.

2. This Bylaw shall have full force and take effect on the final passing thereof.
