

The Town of Rosetown
Bylaw No. 893-23
A Bylaw to Amend Bylaw No. 765-17 (The Traffic Bylaw)

The Council of the Town of Rosetown, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That section 3.1 (rr) of Bylaw No. 765-17 (The Traffic Bylaw) be amended to read as follows:

(rr) "SCHOOL BUS" shall mean a motor vehicle designed for the conveyance of school children and other people. For the purpose of this Bylaw where the term "Heavy Vehicle" is used, it shall be deemed to include "School Bus".

2. That the following be added to Section 3.1 of Bylaw No. 765-17:

(hhh) "HEAVY VEHICLE" shall mean any vehicle with two or more axles that has a gross vehicle weight of more than 4,300 kilograms (9,480 pounds).

3. That section 23 of Bylaw No. 765-17 (The Traffic Bylaw) be amended to read as follows:

23. HEAVY VEHICLE PARKING

4. That section 23.2 of Bylaw No. 765-17 (The Traffic Bylaw) be amended to read as follows:

23.2 No heavy vehicle or power unit attached or unattached to a semi-trailer shall be parked on a roadway or lane in a residential district at any time, unless actually engaged in loading or unloading furniture, goods or merchandise.

5. This Bylaw shall have full force and take effect on the final passing thereof.
