

EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION AGREEMENT

This agreement made in quintuplicate this _____ day of _____, 2017.

BETWEEN:

The Town of Rosetown
(herein after called the Party of the First Part)

AND:

The Rural Municipality of St. Andrews No. 287;
The Rural Municipality of Marriott No. 317;
The Rural Municipality of Pleasant Valley No. 288; and
The Rural Municipality of Mountain View No. 318
The Town of Zealandia
(herein after called the Parties of the Second Part)

Whereas *The Emergency Planning Act 1989*, pursuant to Section 9 provides that the local authority of each municipality shall:

- a. establish a municipal emergency measures organization;
- b. appoint a person as a local emergency measures coordinator;
- c. establish a local emergency planning committee;

AND SHALL prepare and approve emergency plans and programs;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Rosetown enacts as follows:

1. "Emergency" shall mean:
 - i) a calamity caused by accident or by forces of nature; or
 - ii) a present or imminent occurrence that has resulted or may result in serious harm to the safety or welfare of people or in widespread damage to property.
2. The term "Coordinator" shall mean the person appointed by the Council of the Town of Rosetown to organize Emergency Management in the Town of Rosetown.
3. The Emergency Management Organization of the Town of Rosetown shall be comprised of the Emergency Measures Planning Committee, municipal departments and voluntary organizations within the municipality.
4. The Emergency Management Control Group is hereby designated and appointed to be a special committee of the Town of Rosetown and shall be responsible for the carrying out of any emergency measures or emergency activities or works in the furtherance of *The Emergency Planning Act, 1989* or this bylaw and to that end, shall have and is hereby granted and delegated to it the duties and powers of the Town of Rosetown Council except the power to borrow money, to pass a bylaw or enter into any contracts.

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5. The Coordinator shall have the following duties and responsibilities:
 - a. Acts as Chairman of the Emergency Management Planning Committee established under this bylaw;
 - b. Coordinates the development of an emergency plan for the community in co-operation with the departments and agencies of the municipality;
 - c. Provides emergency plans from guidelines laid down by the Emergency Management Control Group;
 - d. Submits regular reports to Town of Rosetown Council to keep them fully informed of progress;
 - e. Correlates all activities of those person and/or organizations involved within the Town of Rosetown and designated for the Emergency Management Organization;
 - f. Ensures that a continuous program of training for local Emergency Management Organization personnel is carried out;
 - g. Cooperates with Emergency Management and Fire Safety on all matters pertaining to planning and operations;
 - h. Submits a projected budget to cover costs of emergency management operations within the municipality;
 - i. Acts as advisor to the Town of Rosetown during emergencies or disasters.

6. There shall be an Emergency Management Planning Committee comprised of the Emergency Coordinator, the Mayor and or the Deputy Mayor of the Town of Rosetown, the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Rosetown, the Superintendent of Public Works of the Town of Rosetown, the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Town of Rosetown, a representative of the Rosetown and District Health Care Center, a representative of the Rosetown Fire Department, a representative of the Rosetown local R.C.M.P. detachment and other persons that may be deemed necessary to formulate a municipal emergency plan.

7. The EMO Planning Committee as a whole, under the coordination of the Chairman will integrate the municipal and voluntary emergency plans into one comprehensive emergency plan.

8. The Council may, from time to time, appropriate and expend monies required to meet the ordinary operating expenses of the said organization.

9. On the making of the declaration and for the duration of the local emergency, the local authority, may do all acts and take all necessary proceedings including the following:
 - i) put into operation any emergency plan or program that the local authority considers appropriate;

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- ii) acquire or utilize any real or personal property that the local authority considers necessary to prevent, combat or alleviate the effects of an emergency;
- iii) authorize any qualified person to render aid of a type that the person is qualified to provide;
- iv) control or prohibit travel to or from any area of the municipality;
- v) provide for the restoration of essential facilities and the distribution of essential supplies;
- vi) provide, maintain and co-ordinate emergency medical, welfare and other essential services in any part of the municipality;
- vii) cause the evacuation of persons and the removal of persons from any area of the municipality that is or may be affected by an emergency and make arrangements for the adequate care and protections of those persons;
- viii) authorize the entry into any building or on any land, without warrant, by any person when necessary for the implementation of an emergency plan;
- ix) conscript persons needed to meet an emergency; and do all acts and take all proceedings that are reasonably necessary to meet the local emergency.

10. The Mayor, or in his/her absence the Deputy Mayor, is hereby authorized to declare a local emergency for the Town of Rosetown. In the absence of the Mayor or Deputy Mayor, a majority of the members of the Town of Rosetown Council are hereby authorized to declare a local emergency in the Town of Rosetown. Upon such a declaration being made the Emergency Management Organization shall exercise all powers conferred upon them by *The Emergency Planning Act, 1989* of the Province of Saskatchewan.

11. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.

12. Bylaw No. 588-10 and any of its amendments are hereby repealed.
