

**The Town of Rosetown
Bylaw No. 851-21**

A Bylaw to provide for agreements under *The Municipalities Act* with respect to assessment on lands not subdivided into lots located within the Town of Rosetown, which are used exclusively for farming purposes.

The Council of the Town of Rosetown in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. (a) That agreements may be entered into with the property owners as listed in Schedule "A", attached to and forming part of this bylaw, covering the property listed opposite the name of each property owner.
- (b) That whereas each property is not subdivided into lots but is used exclusively for farming purposes, while each property remains or continues to be used for farming purposes, a fixed valuation as set forth in said Schedule "A" shall be placed thereon for assessment purposes. The rate of taxation payable by the said owners while such agreements are in effect shall be based upon such a fixed assessment value. The fixed assessment value shall be equal to the assessment on any residential land or improvements or any agricultural land that may exist on each property.
2. The agreements shall be in effect for the period January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2024.
3. That Bylaw No. 829-20 is hereby repealed.
