



## TOWN OF ROSETOWN 2019 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

1. Town Office:
  - a. Completed Landscaping at the Town Office.
  - b. New Town Office signage has been ordered.
  - c. Eves will be replaced this fall.
  - d. New Council table and cabinets purchased for Council Chambers.
  - e. New phone system.
  - f. Maintained the Town of Rosetown Strategic Plan, Tangible Capital Assets and Asset Management.
  
2. Protective Services:
  - a. New EMO Co-ordinator – Brandee Hay.
  - b. Maintain the RCMP contract.
  - c. Fire Department has 3 new volunteers.
  
3. Transportation/Public Works:
  - a. Street Maintenance (pavement patching) – will be completed this fall.
  - b. Will be working on pot holes this fall once the paving plant relocates into our area.
  - c. Working on landscaping at the new Lift Station – will complete in 2020.
  - d. Local Improvement pavement – King Street, St. Andrews Cres., 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue W.
  - e. Started Sidewalk Replacement Program for 2019.
  - f. Created a rolling plan regarding future paving projects.
  - g. Installed water and sewer for the splash park.
  
4. Public & Environmental Health:
  - a. Working with the Health Region and contributing Municipalities regarding Doctor Recruitment.
  - b. Budgeted a \$65,000.00 operating grant regarding Rosetown & District Primary Care Centre.
  - c. Budgeted a \$50,000.00 operating grant regarding Orange Memories.
  - d. Purchased new Columbian for Cemetery - \$15,200.00.
  - e. Budgeted \$20,000.00 for tree pruning at the Cemetery, this will be completed this fall.



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### 5. Recreation:

- a. Budgeted the following grants:
  - i. Rosetown Kinsmen - \$5,000.00
  - ii. Golf Course - \$5,000.00
  - iii. Rosetown Community Youth Project - \$16,000.00
  - iv. Curling Club - \$10,000.00
- b. Saskatchewan Lotteries Fund - \$20,000.00 back into the community.
- c. Ordered and planted 25 new trees
- d. New flower pots purchased.
- e. Purchased new ice edger.
- f. Upgraded the Tourism Booth – new sign, repaint interior, carpet.
- g. New Tourism Book was published and circulated.
- h. New carpet at Elks Hall.
- i. Assumed the operations of the Elks Hall and Civic Centre.
- j. Assisted with splash park.
- k. Installed Pool sun shade.
- l. Purchased new mower.

### 6. Water & Sewer:

- a. Rebuilt 4 high lift pumps and service Well #5 pump.
- b. Continued with upgrading water meters to remote reading meters.
- c. Inspection of the Water Tower and Reservoir was completed.
- d. Budgeted for sewer main camera – will be completed this fall.
- e. Water Treatment Plant – flat roof redone.
