

The Town of Rosetown
Bylaw No. 813-19
A Bylaw to Establish a Fee to Appeal Assessments

The Council of the Town of Rosetown in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Persons desiring to appeal their assessment to the Board of Revision for the Town of Rosetown shall file their appeal in the form prescribed in *The Municipalities Act*.
2. A fee in the amount of:

Agricultural Class Appeal	\$100.00 per property appeal
Residential Class Appeal	\$100.00 per property appeal
Commercial Class Appeal	\$200.00 per property appeal
Industrial Class Appeal	\$200.00 per property appeal

shall accompany the form, or shall be paid to the Town of Rosetown within 30 days of the notice of assessment being published in the Saskatchewan Gazette pursuant to subsection 217(1) of *The Municipalities Act*.

3. Where the appellant is successful in whole or in part on an assessment or classification appeal at either the board of revision or the appeal board, the Town shall refund any fee that was submitted by the appellant to the Town.
4. Where an appellant fails to pay the fee pursuant to Section 2 of this bylaw, the appeal is deemed to be dismissed.
5. Bylaw No. 629-12 is hereby repealed.
