

**TOWN OF ROSETOWN
BYLAW NO. 820-19**

A Bylaw to Fix the Rates to be Charged for the Collection of Waste

The Council of the Town of Rosetown, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Whereas the Council may establish and maintain a system for the collection, removal or disposal of all or any household, commercial and industrial solid wastes or other refuse on any terms and conditions that the council considers expedient;

Whereas the Council may establish a schedule of charges payable by owners or occupants of residential land or buildings to the urban municipality for the collection, removal or disposal of household solid wastes or other refuse, and compel the payment of the charges so established;

Definitions:

- a. "Light Commercial and Industrial" means a business or industry that that will discard up to four (4) bags of waste per week.
- b. "Heavy Commercial and Industrial" means a business or industry that will discard more than four (4) bags of waste per week and holds a contract for a waste collection bin and the disposal of said waste.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Rosetown enacts as follows:

1. All residences in the Town of Rosetown shall be charged \$10.00 per month (\$20.00 bi-monthly) for the collection and disposal of household solid wastes.
2. All light commercial/industrial shall be charged \$20.00 per month for the collection and disposal of solid wastes.
3. Each household and light commercial/industrial are allowed two (2) bags, at a maximum weight of 20kg (44 lbs), per schedule pickup. Any additional bags MUST be tagged. Tags can be purchased at the Town Office for \$2.00 per tag.

Household scheduled pickup – once per week

Light commercial/industrial scheduled pickup – twice per week

4. All heavy commercial/industrial shall be charged \$5.00 per month for an environmental fee.
5. Waste collection fees, except for the tag a bag program, shall be placed on the water and sewer bi-monthly billings.
3. That Bylaw No. 771-18 is hereby repealed.
